



## **SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

The East Interlake Conservation District (EICD) is accepting applications from qualified individuals for the seasonal position of **Resource Assistant**.

Reporting to the Resource Planner and GIS Technician, the Resource Assistants will help with a variety of the EICD's programs and projects.

Duties may include:

- Conducting a water well inventory/drinking water education program
- Collecting private well water samples
- Planting shelterbelts and restoring riparian areas
- Conducting waterway and water retention project surveys
- Digitizing survey data and create maps
- Assisting with educational events and promoting the mandate of the Conservation District
- Other office tasks and duties

The preferred applicant will have excellent communication and teamwork skills, a positive attitude, time-management skills, a valid class 5 driver's license, and experience with Microsoft Office computer software. Knowledge of water quality issues and environmental concerns is an asset. Experience with surveying, ATV operation, and GPS/GIS are also considered assets. Preference may be given to post-secondary students in a related area of study and/or youth aged 15-29.

The position will start in May and finish near the end of August 2015. The wage for this position is \$13-15/hour. Applicants will be asked to work Monday – Thursday, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Occasional work on weekends may be required.
